Drink Local Drink Tap (DLDT) is thrilled for you to use our new Wavemaker Curriculum for grades 4-8! We're a nonprofit organization that improves water equity locally and globally through education, engagement and providing safe water access to people in need.

Water is at the heart of some of the biggest challenges facing humanity, and education is a vital way to help solve these issues. Our lesson plans cut straight to key concepts that students need to know to understand water issues and how to put ideas into practice to make a difference locally and globally.

The lessons are standards-based with a **STEM focus** and use **project-based learning** to emphasize collaboration, problem-solving, finding hope, and taking action. They each have Wavemaker pages for student work and include DLDT's newly-created Fact Sheets, compelling documentaries, and many other critical resources. Eight of these lessons contain instructions so they can be taught remotely, as needed.
